## How We Serve Combat Veterans

### Dental Program

Our Dental Program provides our nation's low-income combat veterans with comprehensive dental services that the VA rarely provides. By providing no-cost dental care, we honor and transform the lives of combat veterans through improved health and self-confidence. Our model is efficient and has proven to be very effective. We collaborate with dentists to provide pro-bono dental services in the communities where the veterans live. It would be cost-prohibitive to provide these same services through central clinics, which cost millions to build and operate. By partnering with dentists in the communities where they live, the likelihood of the continuation of care is also increased.

### Wingman Program

Our Wingman Program links local businesses and community volunteers with veterans to provide essential gap services or goods that many low-income veterans struggle to obtain. Many of the Wingman cases result from the veteran needs that are revealed in their application and during the course of dental care. We are involving the local community in the care of veterans, which is a true reflection of our respect for the sacrifices they have made on our behalf. Knowing the community is behind them is also a tremendous morale booster to the veteran which develops self-confidence, provides healing from the physical and emotional wounds of war, and contributes greatly to leading a balanced and productive life.
